





The UBT Health and Safety Champion is a member of a UBT who has volunteered to spread practices and information that promotes health and safety.

UBT Health and Safety Champions spark and organize their UBT to take action. They help show what good health and safety looks like by their actions as well as bring national and regional messages to their own UBTs.

Below are the simple guidelines for those interested in becoming UBT Health and Safety Champions:

- + Be a member of the UBT.
- + Union Coalition members, managers and physicians are welcome.
- + UBT co-Leads are not eligible to become UBT Health and Safety Champions while serving in the co-lead role.
- + There is one UBT Health and Safety Champion per team (unless otherwise determined by the region).
- + The UBT Health and Safety Champion will check with their co-Leads or UBT consultant to ensure their name is listed in UBT Tracker as the UBT Health and Safety Champion.

UBT Health and Safety Champions will make their best efforts to:

- + attend all scheduled UBT meetings
- + stay for the duration of meetings
- + keep their colleagues updated on issues affecting the team
- + work to create a safer workplace that prevents injuries and protects health
